REGULATIONS FOR THE ERECTION OF MEMORIALS

TRADITIONAL OPEN SPACES

Memorials on tradition open ground are subject to the following conditions:

- If you wish to place items on the grave you must apply to Clay Cross Parish Council for permission and their decision will be final
- Metal and/or plastic railing will not be allowed around any grave
- Clay Cross Parish Council reserve the right to remove any item placed on or near a grave that does not conform to these Regulations, without prior notice or right of appeal
- No trees, shrubs, plants, flowers, flower-holders, vases, flat stones, headstones, crosses, kerbstones, fencing, gravel or anything else may be placed on the grassed area
- All memorials must be kept in good repair at the expense of the owner of the Exclusive Rights of Burial. Clay Cross Parish Council reserves the right to remove any memorial which, in its opinion, has become unsafe, dilapidated or unsightly, or is not kept in good repair
- Clay Cross Parish Council will remove any item placed on or near a grave that does not conform to these Regulations, without prior notice or right of appeal

As in general lawn sections, we do not permit unauthorised monuments or mementos on the graves. As soon as practicable after settlement of the grave, Clay Cross Parish Council will sow grass seed over the whole area of the surface of the grave.

 No trees, shrubs, plants, flowers, flower-holders, vases, flat stones, headstones, crosses, kerbstones, fencing, gravel, metal or plastic railing around the grave, figurine, toy or anything else may be placed on the grassed area

 Subject to the written consent of Clay Cross Parish Council and to payment of the prescribed fee, a stone vase/flower container may be placed on the grave at the side or immediately in front of the headstone. Under no circumstances will a glass or other breakable receptacle be permitted

A memorial may not be fixed on an unpurchased grave unless, subsequent to the interment, the Exclusive Right of Burial is purchased.

 Clay Cross Parish Council will remove any item placed on or near a grave that does not conform to Regulations, without prior notice or right of appeal

Clay Cross Parish Council may remove, without notice, any monument, memorial, stone, shrub, plant or item whatsoever erected or placed in the Cemetery in contravention of these Regulations. We will store these items for collection.
