Clay Cross Social Centre facilities include: main hall with stage, fully equipped kitchen, fully licensed bar, furnished lounge area, beer garden and car park. We are fully licensed for entertainment with a maximum capacity of 200 persons.

Damage Bond

A £50 damage bond is added on to the above charges. This covers any major incident or damage that may occur during the function. The damage bond will be returned (by cheque) to the Hirer within 14 days of the function date if no major incident or damage has been reported by the Premises Supervisor/Duty Caretaker.

Bar/Beer Garden

Our fully licensed bar managed by the Parish Council is open until 11.30pm and is included in the hire of the main hall. John Smiths bitter and Fosters lager are on draft plus we have a wide range of premium bottled lagers, beers, ciders, spirits, wine by the glass. Soft drinks are also available.

Please note that alcoholic drinks, soft drinks and beverages MUST NOT be brought into these licensed premises (including the beer garden) for sale or consumption by members of the public or hirers of Clay Cross Social Centre.

Unless other arrangements have been made with the Clerk of the Council or Administrative Assistant, ALL bookings must be made in person and a £50 deposit paid by cash or cheque (debit and credit cards are not accepted).

CONDITIONS GOVERNING HIRE OF HALL/LOUNGE/KITCHEN

1. Admission to functions must be monitored by the Hirers and must not exceed 200 persons (including children).
2. Clay Cross Social Centre is opened from the time of booking and must be vacated by all persons at the termination of hiring time.
3. Clay Cross Parish Council and or Premises Supervisor/Duty Caretaker are authorised to terminate any event which in their opinion is of a disorderly nature.
4. No responsibility is taken for the loss or damage of, or to any property brought into the building, including property deposited in the cloakroom.
5. The Hirer shall be responsible for any wilful damage to the building and its contents either fixed or otherwise which is the property of Clay Cross Parish Council.
6. Clay Cross Parish Council has the sole right to sell and dispense all alcoholic drinks, soft drinks, and beverages on and off the premises. Alcoholic drinks, soft drinks, and beverages must not be brought into these licensed premises (including the beer garden) for sale or consumption by members of the public or Hirers of Clay Cross Social Centre, except where other arrangements have been made with Clay Cross Parish Council.
7. Children under the age of 18 are not permitted to enter the bar area and must be kept under parental supervision at all times.
8. Hired disco's must not use smoke machines, dry ice machines, bubble machines and must stop playing music by 11.30pm.
9. Clay Cross Parish Council Premises Supervisor/Duty Caretaker will arrive to open the Social Centre at the booked time and will be in attendance at all times for safety and advice.
10. The Hirer of Clay Cross Social Centre shall be subject to cancellation at any time by notice to the Hirer by Clay Cross Parish Council. No compensation shall be payable by Clay Cross Parish Council or its representatives to any person in consequence of such cancellation.
11. The person hiring Clay Cross Social Centre shall be deemed to have agreed to, and to have undertaken to comply with all the aforementioned conditions.

Outstanding balances must be paid in full, 14 days before the date of your booking. The deposit will be forfeited if the booking is cancelled within 14 days of the date of hire.
